# RAVE-O

## *Bringing Research to Practice*

RAVE-O is a Comprehensive, Fluency-Based Reading Intervention Program. RAVE-O was developed and evaluated at Tufts University's Center for Reading and Language Research. Students who have completed the curriculum have shown significant gains in both specific and global reading skills.

The 12- hour professional development course, distributed over two full days, prepares professionals to implement the curriculum immediately. Professionals will learn: a new conceptualization of reading disorders supported by 25 years of locally and federally supported research by Dr. Maryanne Wolf and the Center for Reading and Language Research, a developmental and multi-component based intervention for reading fluency and comprehension methods and materials of the RAVE-O curriculum to increase accuracy and processing speed in underlying components of reading instructional strategies for putting the RAVE-O curriculum into practice in classroom and tutorial settings through demonstration lessons, considerations for the integration of RAVE-O and other phonological-based programs
